## **Sealaska Subsidiary Wins D.O.E. Contract**

Bellevue, WA— Sealaska Environmental Services, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Sealaska Corporation based in Bellevue, Washington is pleased to announce that it was selected to support the U.S. Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) under the Design, Integration, Construction, Communication, and Engineering (DICCE). SES is the managing partner in a small business joint venture with Tetra Tech EC, Inc., a New Jersey based international environmental remediation company, called SES-TECH Global Solutions. The JV team will share in the \$700 million contract ceiling over the next seven years with two other contract winners.

The DICCE contracts are part of the NNSA Second Line of Defense program's collaboration to provide radiation detection systems for partner countries in order to deter, detect, and interdict illicit trafficking of nuclear and radiological materials. This international program is an integral part of our nation's homeland security. NNSA maintains and enhances the safety, security, reliability and performance of the U.S. nuclear weapons stockpile without nuclear testing; works to reduce global danger from weapons of mass destruction; provides the U.S. Navy with safe and effective nuclear propulsion; and responds to nuclear and radiological emergencies in the United States and abroad.

The SES-TECH Global Solutions team will install radiation detection equipment and accompanying communication systems at land border crossings, seaports, and airports. The DICCE contracts potentially encompass more than 270 sites in 30 countries.

This contract is the largest contract that SES has won to date and provides the growing company a significant platform for continued success at the federal contracting level. SES will utilize its expanding capacity and capabilities in project management and construction management to provide the JV team with high quality services.

There will be opportunities for qualified Sealaska shareholders to participate in this dynamic program.
