Totem Pole Log Request Application

Eligible applicants include Clans and Native communities and/or organizations physically located in southeast Alaska ANCSA and Landless communities. Individuals are not eligible. Applicants must agree to comply with traditional property laws and cultural protocols relating to ownership of crests. Designs must comply with cultural practice. In addition, applicants must agree to comply with requirements of the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (PL 101-644) in regards to the design and production of the totem or project by an Indian artisan and all of the terms outlined below. The law provides that the term "Indian" means any individual who is a member of an Indian tribe or is certified as an Indian artisan by an Indian tribe.
